International: Credit card via PayPal is RECOMMENDED FOR NON- US MEMBERS

Payment Methods: Note that payments are only accepted in **US Dollar currency**. Receipts are provided by email (pdf attachment).

- PayPal** Please note that due to the extremely high cost of processing credit card payments via our banking provider we WILL be switching **ALL** credit card processing in the near future to PayPal where you can pay by your credit card **without** opening an account. Making dues payments via our online payment system is **very** easy with step by step instructions. Go to www.tsop.org/dues or login at www.tsop.org/mbrsonly and select 'Online payments'. Note: Please check the PayPal selection box and wait until we contact you about accessing TSOP's online payment system.
- Credit card** (see PayPal note above) Enter information in form below. **Note:** The most common problem encountered in dealing with credit cards is the legibility of the numbers/digits as received. If there is any doubt as to the readability of the information may I suggest that you first type the requested information, verify that the typed information is correct and then send it by a secure method (mail / fax or possibly (your choice) a scanned image email attachment). Alternatively, you can provide the information by phone.
- Checks** (Cheques) Preferred payment method for US members. Make payable to **TSOP**.
- Money orders** (Bank or Postal) Make payable to **TSOP**. Funds must be drawn on a US bank account. Available from banks and post offices in many countries for a small fee.
- Direct transfer** (Wire / Bank transfer / EFT) Contact TSOP Treasurer (M. Avery) for instructions.
- Cash** Sending cash by mail is not advised but accepted if received. **Note:** TSOP assumes no responsibility for cash lost in mail.

Dues pricing structure and newsletter costs: In order to reduce costs and therefore keep membership dues as low as possible we have introduced a dual rate dues system. For members who agree to download their quarterly newsletter from the TSOP website [www.tsop.org] the rate will remain at the \$25/yr (or \$100/5yrs) level but for those members who want a printed newsletter mailed to them we are raising the dues to \$30/yr (or \$120/5 yrs). There is a similar \$5 differential for Student and Institutional categories. Creating the two dues rates allows us to take advantage of lower printing and mailing costs realized when members use the download method while also providing other members with the option of receiving a printed copy by post. Display Name: TSOP would like to provide members with the opportunity to set the format of their name as they would like it to appear on correspondence with the Society.
